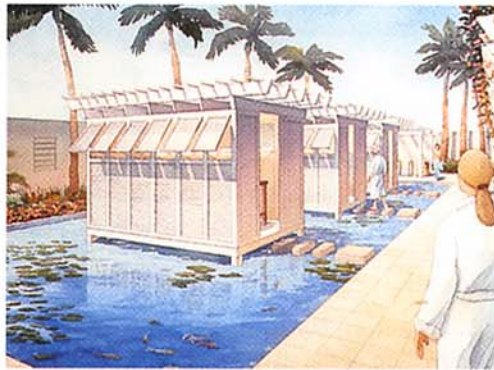

## Spa Scores a Hole-In-One



**St. Augustine, Fla.**—The World Golf Village, a top golf resort in St. Augustine, Fla., is about to add another luxury to its list of amenities. Architect Robert D. Henry has designed its new spa, scheduled to open at the end of the year. As part of the exclusive Lateral development, the PGA Spa at World Golf Village will serve golfers, residents, and visitors. “The Lateral development integrates the indoor and outdoor environments into exquisitely landscaped courtyards and gathering spaces,” says Henry. “We have further developed that sensibility within the PGA Spa, creating a series of distinctive environments, culminating in a meticulous outdoor garden.”

Inspired by St. Augustine’s healing water, and Ponce de Leon’s mythical fountain of youth, the PGA Spa incorporates the soothing energy of water in its many forms, including fountains, streams, pools, and reflecting ponds. Located on the first floor of Lateral’s main building, the 9,000-sq. ft. spa is a modern interpretation of a classical plan. Entering the spa, the visitor steps down into a rectangular room wrapped in rich wenge paneling accented with marble piers. Further in, the interior is anchored by a central fountain, complete with luxurious chaises, and candles. The outdoor garden—the spa’s signature space—features a large reflecting pool containing three floating, wooden teahouses that act as outdoor massage pavilions. The reflecting pool leads to an adjacent outdoor hot tub, and a special treatment room overlooks the garden and ponds.
